#### UTS HOSTEL MERIT/DEMERIT SYSTEM

### BACKGROUND

The University of Technology Sarawak (UTS) provides hostel facilities for outstation students. The occupants are expected to take good care of it, so as to benefit more students in future. Among others is the introduction of the Merit and Demerit system. The system, based on guidelines stipulated in the UCTS Student Code of Conduct acts a guidelines with regards to the DOs & DONTs while occupying the UCTS hostels facilities.

# **OBJECTIVES:**

The objectives of this system are to:

- Promote and encourage appropriate behaviors in hostels at all time.
- Reward and recognize occupant for extra services and volunteering efforts.
- Create conducive environment for living and learning in hostels.
- Determine disciplinary mechanism for willful disregard for the campus rules and regulations.
- Give priority to students with higher merit points occupying hostels in subsequent semester.

### **IMPLEMENTATION:**

- 1. The merit/demerit is applicable to every hostel occupant.
- 2. Spot check will be carried out at least once a week.
- 3. Points are awarded according to guidelines in the Merit & Demerit Point tables.
- 4. Merit points are accumulated through participation in meritorious acts, good behaviors, and active participation in the hostel's functions and activities at the Individual, Unit and Block level.
- 5. Demerit points are deducted through misconduct, abnormal human behaviors or violation of the UCTS Student Code of Conduct.
- 6. Occupants with lower points are given opportunities to improve their merit points by doing positive activities except those referred to the Student Disciplinary Council.
- 7. Records of the Merit / Demerit points will be kept in the occupant's personal file.
- 8. When total points fall below minimum level, the management has the right to expel occupant concern by giving a 1 month notice.
- 9. Accumulated merit points shall be used to determine occupants priority to stay in hostel throughout their study in UCTS.

# MERIT/DEMERIT POINTS

At the commencement of staying in UCTS hostels, every students is awarded 50% merit points on the following basis:

- 1. **Cleanliness & Hygiene**: The hostel rooms equip with basic facilities are clean and hygienic to live in.
- 2. **Good Attitude**: Occupants possessed positive outlook like respectful, cooperative, kind and rational while occupying the rooms allocated.
- 3. **Good Health**: Occupants are in reasonably good health, free from smoking, drugs, alcohol or anything illegal substances according to the law of Malaysia.
- 4. **Positive Lifestyle**: Occupants practice positive lifestyle like exercise regularly, responsible and caring towards others and environment.
